
MAKING THE MOST OF MEMBERSHIP TRACKING

Session Description

As a church grows, keeping up with who does what, who's gifted in that, and who loves doing this can be a daunting task. A membership tracking program can be a lifesaver for the church. But too many churches purchase membership tracking programs and then use them primarily, or too often exclusively, for giving reports. And yes, that's a good use ... but it's only one use, and not even the best. In this episode Drs. Kris and Bill look at how the church can effectively use a membership tracking program. Membership tracking programs are for more than just giving records, though most of them do that well. But if that's all a church uses it for, it's missing out on some of the most important features.

Membership Tracking Programs are “relational databases” (not a spreadsheet)

Membership tracking can:

- Can track contact information (some can even create a membership directory complete with pictures!)
- Can track attendance in worship, Sunday school, small groups, etc.
- Can track members' spiritual gifts, passions, talents, skills – helps with nominations
- Can help you match ministries to people
